- Investment Committee Meeting held this week
 - 1. Looking at SRI managers for International Equity space choosing between Global Currant and Boston Common Asset Management
 - 2. Both firms made excellent presentations; a little bit leaning toward Boston Common
 - The committee decided to cut Artio and Templeton back to 5% and hire both Common and Global – NEPC will do the notifications, by next quarter this will all be in place
